



## **GDPR Statement**

It is the policy of Peacehaven Trust (CLG) in conjunction with the Presbyterian Church in Ireland, that all data will be processed and controlled in line with the principles of GDPR and relevant Irish legislation.

Peacehaven Trust adheres to the Charity Regulatory Authority (CRA)'s fundraising standards and complies with their Governance Code.

Peacehaven Trust is committed to protecting personal information and being transparent about what information we hold about you, whether you are a **visitor** to our website, a newsletter recipient, a **financial supporter**, a **volunteer** or **participant** in one of our services, or a **prayer supporter**.

Our policy explains how we collect, use and store the personal information you provide to us, whether this is online, in person or via phone, mobile, email, letter or other correspondence or printed form, and personal information about you that we may obtain from third parties.

If you use our website or any of our services, or provide us with any personal information, we will bring this policy to your attention so that you are fully aware of how your information will be used and disclosed.

Peacehaven Trust (CLG) in conjunction with the Presbyterian Church in Ireland aims to ensure that individuals are aware that their data is being processed and that they understand:

- How the data is being used.
- How to exercise their rights in relation to same.

To these ends, Peacehaven Trust (CLG) will issue privacy notices as appropriate to residents, employees, customers, suppliers, business contacts, and other individuals we have a relationship with or may need to contact, setting out how data relating to an individual is used by us, how to exercise their rights in relation to same including options available and how to raise a complaint.

Peacehaven Trust (CLG) does not sell or share any information about you to other organisations. Relevant information is made available to the Council for Social Witness of the Presbyterian Church in Ireland.

The Data Protection Act and the General Data Protection Regulations give you certain rights over your data and how we use it. You have the right to request a copy of the information we hold about you and details of what we do with that information (known as a subject access request, SAR).
